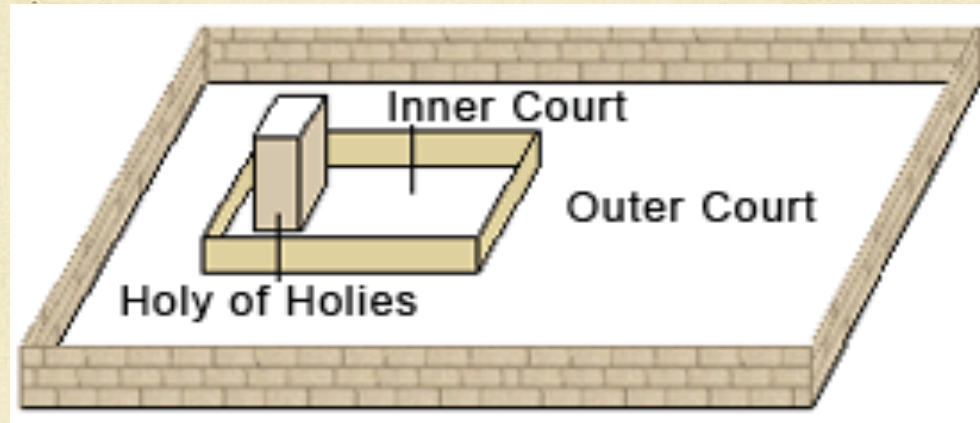




Temple of God

Levels of Prayer

Outer Court

Outer court Christians have asked Jesus into their hearts but have not gone any further in discipleship. If they pray they rarely hear from God. If on the odd occasion they pray for others their prayers are not heard as they are the furthest away from the Holy Place where God resides. This is where most Christians stay.



The idea here is once you receive Jesus as Lord and saviour you leave your sinful life and follow him. This outer court is where Christians can drop off their sin on the brazen altar and have the world or flesh burned off them in the Holy fire of God- purifying them. They move from the altar to the laver where you can see your reflection, the laver resembles the word of God and through this 'checking yourself' process you are being cleansed to enter into the next level of fellowship with the Lord.

Prayer can be hindered here because of sin. Prayer for yourself is usually all that is available in this court. We see many Christians struggling and frustrated with life in this court due to sin.

Inner Court- Holy Place

- Here is where you come once the mind is renewed and washed from sin and you have been cleansed by the Holy Spirit.
- Here is the bread, the anointing of the spirits of God and pure worship. Here we receive the anointing and can pray more effectively for others. Our prayers in this next level are heard and answered more quickly. In this court we tend to intercede for others needs more than our own.





Most Holy Place



- This is the final level and it is where prayer is answered instantly. It is where the pure light of God dwells. This is where your heart is pure and you are bold. Only those who are pure in heart and bold enter here, without boldness and a pure heart it is impossible to see God. My righteous ones are bold as lions- Psalm 24:4
- Having therefore brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus- Hebrews 10:19
- It's where you see God- Matthew 5:8
- This is where you experience the continual oneness in the glory of God. It is where all believers should live. It is in here God speaks face to face with you.
